

He was also one of the official delegate of The Institute of Chartered Accountants of India and visited Australia, China, Colombo, Hong-Kong, Malaysia, Singapore and Middle East countries and studied the corporate practices, economic scenario and professional practices and standards in those countries.

Sri. R. Ananda's services to the education field are, he has served as Director, Modern Institute of Management and Business Administration offering Management Education courses of Bangalore University, Chairman of Finance Sub Committee and Senate Member of Bangalore University, Member, Board of Management of various Colleges of Bangalore University, Member Board of Studies and Faculty of Commerce and Management of Bangalore University as one of the subject expert. He also served as one of the member of Fee Fixation Committee for professional courses of Government of Karnataka.
